

TRAVEL TO AFRICA









Social Justice


SOCIAL JUSTICE & ART

DEVELOPMENT

\$1,000

This training includes a one day 1.5 hour training presenting 2 lessons for teachers and administrators only. It is highly interactive. The trainer will deliver the lesson plan with teachers acting as students. Space for questions and feedback is allotted. Teachers will receive all necessary resources to deliver the lessons plan independently.

ASSEMBLY IMMERSION

\$2,000 This training includes a 5-day residency with 2 sessions per day. Assemblies allow two combined classes to attend each session. Four arts integrated lesson plans will be modeled. The session will prepare students for a culminating performance. Fifth day is reserved for student performances, teacher feedback, and material review. Teachers will receive all necessary resources to deliver the lesson plans independently.
